

## Checkerboard Star Block

Cutting Instructions

| Background | A | $1-7 \frac{1}{4 \prime \prime}$ square |
| :---: | :---: | :--- |
|  | B | $4-3 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ ' squares |
| Star Points | C | $1-7 \frac{3}{4 \prime}$ square |
| Checkerboard Color \#1 | D | $8-2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |
| Checkerboard Color \#2 | E | $8-2^{\prime \prime}$ squares |

Piecing Instructions:
Piece D squares to E squares.


Make eight. Unit should measure $31 / 2 \times 2$ ". TIP: Press seams towards darker color to assist in nesting seams later.

Piece one D/E unit to another D/E unit.


Make four. Unit should measure $61 / 2 \times 2$.

Piece D/E strips to each other, following layout and nesting seams.


Make one.


Checkerboard unit should measure $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2 \prime$.

Draw diagonal lines $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the center on the wrong side of the Fabric $C$ square.

Make one.


Cut the Fabric C square into quarters.
Fabric $C$ unit should measure $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
Make four.


Layer two Fabric C units on opposite ends of the Fabric A square.

Stitch on the two drawn lines and cut apart between the stitched lines.

Make two.


Layer one Fabric $C$ unit on the top right corner of a Fabric C/A unit.

Stitch on the two drawn lines and cut apart between the stitched lines.

Flying Geese unit should measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
Make four.


Assemble the Sarah's Choice Block.
Sarah's Choice Block should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½.
Make one.
